

Scope of the Sri Lanka Journal of Social Sciences (SLJSS)

Sri Lanka Journal of Social Sciences (SLJSS) was launched in 1978 as a premier social science journal in Sri Lanka. Published twice a year (in June and December), it entertains social science contributions in the form of Research articles, Review articles, Work-in-progress articles and Correspondence, and publishes invited Book Reviews. The journal publishes social science articles in Sinhala, Tamil and English languages, on topics relevant to Sri Lanka in particular and South Asia in general. All papers are subjected to double-blind peer-review. The journal provides open access to all its articles through the Sri Lanka Journals Online (SLJOL) forum supported by the International Network for the Availability of Scientific Publications (INASP). All articles in the journal are published under the Creative Commons License 'Attribution-No Derivatives - CC BY-ND 4.0' since 2018. SLJSS is indexed in SCOPUS and ESCI.
